2025 DDRSA Registrar Report

The 2024/25 season marked a year of strong growth for the Darling Downs Regional Swimming Association (DDRSA). Following a period of slight decline in the previous season, DDRSA rebounded with a notable increase in total registrations and continued engagement across all age groups and participation types.

This season saw the successful reactivation of **Miles, Tambo and Tara clubs** and the welcome addition of **Western Aquatics** to our region.

This represents a **9.1% increase in total membership**, reversing the decrease of 36 members observed in the prior season. The growth is a strong indicator of renewed community interest, successful grassroots programs, and effective club operations.

Top 5 Clubs by Membership:

1. **Goondiwindi** – 172 members
2. **Gatton** – 137 members
3. **Toowoomba Grammar** – 129 members
4. **Toowoomba East** – 119 members
5. **Allora** – 118 members

Reminder to Clubs Regarding Committee Membership Requirements

I would like to remind all clubs that **any individual currently holding, or intending to hold, a position on a club committee must be a current registered member of DDRSA and Qld Swimming, Either with a Parent Membership or a Non Swimmer Membership**. This is a mandatory requirement to ensure alignment with our insurance coverage.

Please also note that **memberships for the current season will expire on June 30**, and **there will no longer be a carry-over period extending to September 30** as in previous years. Clubs are advised to ensure all relevant individuals renew their memberships promptly to maintain eligibility and compliance.

2024/25 season saw the introduction of new memberships.

Junior Swimmers - 9 years of age or younger (as at 1 June), and are at any level of their swimming journey (e.g. training and club nights only, or competing at inter club meets)

Youth Swimmers - 10 years or older (as at 1 June), who intend to compete at meets from inter club up to and including State Championships.

National Swimmers - 10 years or older (as at 1 June), who intend to compete at a National Championships (e.g. National Open Water, National Age Championships, National Open Championships, Australian Trials etc.).

Below is a complete table of current membership numbers for each club, with past season's figures provided for comparison. I would like to sincerely thank all clubs for their excellent work in managing and growing memberships.

I also wish to extend my gratitude to the current DDRSA Executive Committee, Club Committees, and all members of the region for your support and for welcoming me into the Registrar role. It has been a thoroughly enjoyable and rewarding year.

Finance Subcommittee Report

It is with pleasure that I present the Finance Subcommittee Report and Treasurer's Report to the Annual General Meeting of the members of the Darling Downs Regional Swimming Association (DDRSA).

Following my report is the Association's Audited Financial Report for the 12 months 31 March 2025 which shows a net loss for the year of \$20 693.96. The net assets position of the Association at the end of the 2024-25 season remains very healthy at \$51 996.91 with strong cash reserves.

Key items from the 2024-25 season in relation to budget expectations include:

- Income from club affiliation and swimmer registrations was \$22 914.50, up by \$2 258.50 from the 2023-24 season – however it should be noted that this increase is primarily driven by the increase in membership numbers for the 2024-25 season
- There was no sponsorship payments provided – recommend that we pursue sponsorship for the 2025-26 season
- Income from Regional Association held meets was overall above budget – with overall nomination numbers above expectations
- Income from Awards Dinner was down by 50% - recommend review of the Association's subsidising of the ticket prices
- Development & Team event costs were below Budget
- Depreciation expenditure decreased for the 2024-25 season
- The net loss can be attributed to increase in pool & venue hire fees and medals & trophies expenses – note negotiation of pool hire for the 2025-26 season has been addressed with relevant stakeholders

Financial Statement period ending 31st March 2025

A number of aged cheques which have not been presented are still showing in the accounting software. These cheques have been cancelled and reissued where appropriate. These cheques do not have an impact on the financial report; however it is recommended to remove these as a matter of tidying up the software.

The Finance Subcommittee will action all necessary procedure changes to address the identified items.

Appointment of Auditor

The Finance Subcommittee proposes to retain B & A Accounting Group as the Association's auditor for 2025-26 season.



Note 1: Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1981. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

(a) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

(b) Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where appropriate, any accumulated depreciation.

The amount of all PPE is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

(c) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the assets and liabilities statement are shown inclusive of GST.

(d) Trade and Other Payables

Trade and other payables represent the liability outstanding at the end of the reporting period for goods and services received by the company during the reporting period, which remain unpaid. The balance is recognised as a current liability with the amounts normally paid within 30 days of recognition of the liability.

(e) Income Tax Expense

The association is exempt from Income Tax under Sec. 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

DDRSA Selection Criteria

The selection criteria for the 2025-2026 season are as follows:

State Regional Relays: 13th December 2025

- A swimmer must swim at least one 50m event to be considered for the Relay Team and the selection of the teams follow the Qualifying meets on a weekend in November 2025. (The actual weekend to be TBC)
- The swimmers times will only be taken from 50m long course events.
- All meet results from July 2025 will be taken into consideration; however, the later meets will have a major bearing.
- Two teams (if applicable) will be selected per age division

JX Level Up Teams Challenge: TBC

A team will be selected from the following events:

- The DDRSA SC meets (TBC: TGSC, Fairholme, DDRSA SC Champs)
- The SQ SC Prep meet
- 2024-2025 JX Levels as assigned by Swimming Australia
- Other meets that have been swum since the end of the 2024/2025 season may be taken into consideration with advice from a swimmer's current coach - ALL short course meet results from July 2025 will be taken into consideration; however the later meets will have a major bearing.
- Swimmers must have a minimum of 2 JX times in a specified level to be eligible
- Team will be selected with input from the Selectors committee as well as Club coaches

- All Transition and Preparation meets will be require to use marshalling sheets and Self Marshalling is to be used.
- All Transition and Preparation meets will be require to provide a timeline which will have to be provided to the DDRSA the Monday before the meet as well as a competitor entry check list to be emailed to all competing clubs/competitors.

	MEET TYPES:
DEVELOPMENT MEET	Development Meets are run by a region or club and don't require you to have achieved a qualifying time in order to enter. These meets generally run no longer than 3 hours and follow a recommended events program prepared by Swimming Queensland. Times achieved at these meets may be used to qualify for Preparation Meets and Regional Championships.
TRANSITION MEET	Similar to Development Meets, Transition Meets are run by a region or club and don't require you to have achieved a qualifying time in order to enter. These meets generally run no longer than 4 hours and follow a recommended events program prepared by Swimming Queensland. Times achieved at Transition Meets can be used for all other meets, including Regional, State and National Championships.
PREPARATION MEET	Preparation Meets are also run by a region or club and are considered the next step on the pathway from Transition or Development meets. Some Preparation Meets may have qualifying times and Rule Tolerances are not applied at these meets. These meets may run over one or two days and follow a recommended events program prepared by Swimming Queensland. Times achieved at Preparation Meets can be used for all other meets, including Regional, State and National Championships.
